### ANNUAL MEETING - Saturday, June 8th

#### **BYLAWS AMENDMENT**

A dissolutions clause has been added to the bylaws in the event the Board dissolved. The proposed language for Article 17 states – *Distribution of assets upon dissolution of Dallas Lake Property Owners' Association Inc. will be determined by the Board of Directors.* This amendment will be voted on at the Annual Meeting.

### WATER QUALITY TESTING

A new Strategic Water Quality Management Program (SWQM) for LaGrange County is being launched to be co-administered by the St. Joe River Basin Commission and the LaGrange County Soil & Water Conservation District (*Details will be posted on our website*). Dallas Lake will be one of many lakes participating in the voluntary testing portion of the program. Board member, Maggie Pechin will serve as our Water Quality Program Volunteer Coordinator and oversee, at a minimum, monthly collection of water samples to measure e. Coli, Nitrate, Phosphate and Total Suspended Solids. Other elements that will be tested utilizing a meter purchased by Five Lakes Conservation Association and contributions from each of the 5 lakes, include Water Temperature, Ph and Dissolved Oxygen. Dallas Lake's contribution to the meter and cost of lab analysis of samples comes from our Water Quality Fund.

#### EROSION/LAKE AND RIVER ENHANCEMNT (LARE) GRANT

Work has begun on two shoreline stabilization projects on Dallas Lake. The properties involved are the Scudder property located just east of the Dallas Lake Park beach area and the Yoder property on the west end of the north shore. Made possible through the Indiana DNR's Lake and River Enhancement (LARE) grant, the pilot project primarily consists of placement of natural glacier fieldstone and installation of native plants within the fieldstone matrix along the shorelines to minimize erosion. The LARE grant pays for 80% of the project with the other matching 20% paid for by the two property owners. This is in partnership with Dallas Lake Association who is the business entity registered with the State of Indiana and serving as the administrative agent overseeing the project and the conduit to allow for pass through of funds from the state. Both projects should be completed by late spring to early summer of this year. A special thanks to Steve Vaughn and Nate Thomas of the DNR who have visited several times and continue to offer hands-on help and valued input.





#### WALLEYE FISH FUND

Dallas is a great lake for Walleye and we're excited it was stocked last fall with 6" to 8" walleyes from Fawn River Hatchery. The fish should grow to about 12" in one year. Thank you to everyone who contributed! We need everyone's participation in an honor system that ensures the Walleye are NOT kept if caught under the legal size of 16".

#### KEEP OUR LAKE HEALTHY

USE PHOSPHORUS-FREE FERTILIZER ONLY to help keep our lake healthy.

- Most turf grass does NOT need more phosphorus. Grass needs mostly nitrogen for green growth.
- The 2<sup>nd</sup> number on a fertilizer bag shows the % P...it should be "0".
- P-free fertilizer is widely available...or you can ask for it at your local garden center.

The newest fund, the <u>Fish Fund</u>, was added last year to stock the lake with Walleye. Finally, the <u>General Fund</u> is used for all other Dallas Lake Association expenses. This includes the annual meeting, newsletters, signage, and other items determined by the board of directors.

We appreciate everyone who pays their \$25 dues at the beginning of the lake season – you make a difference. We also thank those residents who contribute above the \$25 to ensure that all funds maintain a healthy balance.
